The Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA) is seeking a dynamic new leader for a top management position at the helm of its criminal enforcement program in Washington, D. C. The Deputy Director works in close partnership with the Director to lead and manage this critical and high-visibility program. The Deputy Director is often called upon to serve as Acting Director, works directly with the Assistant Administrator for OECA (a Presidential appointee), and will have significant responsibility and opportunity for the future shaping of this important program.

The Office of Criminal Enforcement, Forensics and Training (OCEFT) is OECA's largest office, with over 350 employees located throughout the country, including special agents, attorneys, scientists, and technical and other support personnel. OCEFT's mission is to address and deter the most serious, criminal violations of federal environmental laws in the nation, to ensure protection of public health and the environment. The program provides expertise and guidance to OECA's Assistant Administrator on all matters pertaining to criminal enforcement for violations of environmental regulations and statutes; it offers technical and scientific support to OECA's civil enforcement programs, as well as the criminal program; and it provides training to Federal, State and local lawyers, inspectors, civil and criminal investigators and technical experts according to statutory mandate.
