FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

18th Annual NNALEA National Training Conference September 14 – 16, 2010 Las Vegas, Nevada

Conference Background

Q: What is the focus of the 2010 NNALEA National Training Conference?

A: The focus of this year's training is on the key role of Indian Country professionals in law enforcement, public safety, emergency services, homeland security, community policing, and the protection and preservation of the environment and natural resources and ancestral artifacts.

Q: How many tracks of training will take place at the conference?

A: There will be five (5) "Tracks" of training:

1. Emergency Management and Emergency Services
2. Community Policing: Partnerships, Strategies and Operations
3. Boots on the Ground for Law Enforcement Officers
4. Executive and Supervisory Management
5. Environment and Natural Resources

Q: What is a "Track of Training" at the NNALEA Conference?

A: A "Track of Training" consists of 12 "Training Blocks" over a period of three days. Each "Training Block" is one-and-a-quarter (1.25) hours in length.

Q: Will there be "Pre-Registration" at the conference?

A: Yes, conference "Pre-Registration" will begin at 9:00 am and end at 5:00 pm on Monday, September 13, 2010. Registration will continue at 7:00 am through Noon on Tuesday, September 14, 2010.

Q: Will there be “Special Events” during the 2010 NNALEA Conference?

A: Yes, the following “Special Events” are planned to take place during the 2010 NNALEA National Training Conference:

- Second Annual 5k Run/Walk on the evening of Monday, September 13, 2010
- “Opening Ceremonies” on Tuesday, September 14, 2010 starting at 9:00 am
- “President’s Working Lunch” on Tuesday, September 14, 2010 from 11:30 am – 1:15 pm
- “Working Lunch” on Wednesday, September 15, 2010 from Noon – 1:15 pm
- “Native American Awards Dinner” on Wednesday, September 15, 2010 from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm
- “Working Lunch” on Thursday, September 16, 2010 from 12:00 Noon – 1:15 pm
- “Closing Ceremonies” on Thursday, September 16, 2010 from 5:30 pm – 5:45 pm
- “NNALEA Membership Meeting” on Thursday, September 16, 2010 starting at 6:00 pm

Q: After the conference ends, what day should I plan to return to my place of residence or place of work?

A: The Conference ends at 5:45 pm on Thursday, September 16, 2010. The official return travel day is Friday, September 17, 2010.

Conference Location/Lodging

Q: What is the conference hotel?

A: The conference will be held at the Riviera Hotel, 2901 Las Vegas Blvd South, Las Vegas, Nevada 89109. Room blocks have been set aside for the 2010 NNALEA National Training Conference attendees

Q: What is the conference lodging rate?

A: NNALEA has secured the rate of \$69/night plus state and local taxes at the Riviera Hotel.

Air Travel and Ground Transportation

Q: What airport is closest to the conference site?

A: McCarran International Airport (Airport code LAS), which is located 5.5 miles from the Riviera Hotel.

Q: Is there a hotel shuttle to and from the airport?

A: No, however, regular taxis and public shuttle services are available at the airport. A shuttle ride costs approximately \$7 per person and takes about 30 minutes. A taxi costs approximately \$20 one-way and takes 15 to 30 minutes depending on traffic.

Registration Fee and Payment

Q: What is the cost to attend the conference?

A: The conference registration fee is \$400 per person through July 15, 2010. After July 15 the conference fee is \$425. ***All conference registration fees are non-refundable.***
